In the past year I had several gastric attacks for which I should go to the hospital for the Gastroenterology on the 5th December 1989 and it could result in me being hospitalised there.

Apart from that I have some serious problems with my eyes for which obviously I have to have surgical treatment.

This partial sight loss is very unfortunate for a writer like me, who needs to write every day.

I would be very grateful if you would kindly extend my visa for further one or two years.

I live in my own flat and have funds in my bank account, my son who is living and working in London, will help me in every way.

Dear Sirs,

I am writing this letter to request to consider me for an indefinite leave to remain in the United Kingdom. My leave to remain in this country on my last application had been extended for two years and expires at the end of January 1993. I will, therefore send you my passport once you request it, or prior to the expiry of my visa.

I have been residing in London for more than 10 years. I came here in February 1982, to visit my son and also for some medical treatment, because of my poor health. And over the last few years I have been under the care of British doctors.

I would now like to present a brief resume of my background. My earliest education was in Esfahan IRAN in the British Missionary School. Consequently from an early age I was exposed to the British Culture and the way of life.

For higher education I acquired a doctorate degree in literature. By profession I am a poet and have published several volumes of poems, most of them have been translated and published in different languages. But due to some of my recent publications concerning the womens situation in IRAN I am not in a good position to return there.

On several occasions, I was invited by some literary organisations in several different countries to attend the writers conferences, but as I do not have a permanent status in this country, I was worried about accepting these invitations.

I am a seventy years old retired and separated person. I own a flat in 76. Bollo Bridge Road, Acton, London W3, and have some funds in the bank for my expences (statement enclosed). My son Mehrdad Badi of 63. Colet Gardens, London W14, will also undertake to meet any of my additional expences. (his letter enclosed). He has been residing in this country since July 1977 and presently is gainfully employed and lives in his own house.

I shall be immensely grateful if you will give your kind consideration to my application.
